

Scoutbook has been chosen as this tool and most scouts have been uploaded into the system along with the majority of the Adult Leaders. So what's this all about? It's a cloud based system that allows parents to provide their son access to their rank advancements and awards. It allows for a great way for patrols to stay in touch with one another. It allows for each scout to see how far they have until their next rank. It provides for an on-line calendar that will link with all functions. And that's just the beginning.

Parents should look for an email soon that will 'invite' them into Scoutbook. Once invited, each parent can edit their account and provide their information as well as their son's information. They can add their son's email which will help communication among scouts for events and planning.
