Court of Honor (CoH)

<u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of the CoH is to award each Scout for his accomplishments made since the previous CoH. Rank advancement, merit badge completion, hikes completed, special camp awards and special scouting awards are presented at this meeting. Earned advancement pins, service pins, merit badges, hiking patches and special awards are provided to each Scout. Rank advancement pins are given to the mother of the Scout to wear and merit badges are subsequently sewn onto the Scout's sash (part of his uniform).

The Scout will also receive rank advancement and merit badge cards at the CoH. These cards are needed for the Eagle Scout notebook. Consider storing all of the blue cards, merit badge cards, rank cards and service cards in a binder with baseball card holders. Check to make sure the dates on the cards received at the CoH match those in the Scout's handbook and on the blue cards.

CoH is held twice a year – once in the spring and once in the fall. Dates are set at the beginning of each calendar year and are listed in the Troop calendar on the troop website (http://www.troop849.org/).

Where is Mr. Slocum?

Wow! 2,250 miles out and day 123 Location: Mr. Slocum was in the Mount

Hood area

Mr. Slocum has just crossed into Washington state and has surpassed the 2,200 mile mark. In the first 100 days of hiking, he averaged 18 miles/day and has climbed well in excess of 250,000'. That is 47 miles straight up! He is consistently averaging eleven back hours (BPHs) each day. On good days he does more like 15 BPH. His toughest day so far was one where he went 40 miles and climbed 3,600', or over 23 BPH. To put that in perspective, our toughest weekend hikes doesn't 6 BPH. He is amazing!

Philmont 12 day Backpacking Trek
