Special Opportunity for Troop 849 Scouts and Parents

Amateur radio is licensed by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) allowing licensed individuals to operate radio transmitters for domestic and international communications. Handheld amateur radios have longer range capability than CB or FRS radios and by using radio repeaters, reliable communication can be achieved throughout the southland and even wider areas. This makes HAM radio a preferred communication method for emergency response teams and a back up when cell phones and land lines fail after disasters.

Mr. Vahey has offered to teach a radio class, that would lead to you becoming a licensed Amateur (HAM) radio operator and Radio Merit Badge. See an email from October 31 Announce for more details. If you have interest in participating, let Mr. Rolandelli or Mr. Vahey know. We hope to use licensed hand held radios for the long bike trip next Spring.
